

# BIOGRAPHY



## UNITED STATES AIR FORCE COLONEL MOHAN S. KRISHNA

Colonel Mohan S. Krishna serves as Director, Air Force Complaints Resolution Directorate, Secretary of the Air Force Inspector General. He develops and implements Air Force Fraud, Waste and Abuse prevention policy and executes the Inspector General Complaints Resolution program by coordinating with all Air Force and appropriate Department of Defense and Service Inspectors General staffs. Additionally, he evaluates investigative findings to identify systemic problems and staffs' corrective actions to the Secretary of the Air Force and the Air Force Chief of Staff.

In May 1992, Colonel Krishna graduated from the US Air Force Academy and entered the Air Force. In August 1992, he attended the Aircraft Maintenance and Munitions Officer Course at Chanute AFB, Illinois, and served as an F-16C Maintenance Officer at Moody AFB,



Georgia. In 1995 he attended Joint Undergraduate Navigator Training at NAS Pensacola, Florida. Colonel Krishna arrived at Offutt AFB, Nebraska, for the first time in March 1997 where he served as an Electronic Warfare Officer in the 343d Reconnaissance Squadron until 2000. He then served as the Executive Officer, 55th Operations Group, Offutt AFB, Nebraska, then returned to the 343d Reconnaissance Squadron as a Flight Commander until July 2003. His next assignment was as Chief, E-SPACE Operations Center and Operational Requirements Section at the National Security Agency, Fort George G. Meade, Maryland.

In August 2005, Colonel Krishna attended the Air Command and Staff College at Maxwell AFB, Alabama, and following graduation was assigned to Offutt AFB serving as Director of Staff, 343d Reconnaissance Squadron and Operations Officer, 55th Operations Support Squadron. In February 2009, he assumed command of the 343d Reconnaissance Squadron. He then became the Deputy Commander, 55th Operations Group until August 2011, when he was assigned as the Deputy Commander of the 55th Mission Support Group, Offutt AFB, Nebraska, In August of 2012, he was selected for the Counter Terrorism Fellowship Program at the National Defense University, Ft McNair, DC. Upon graduation, he was assigned to the Pentagon as the Deputy Division Chief for Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Collection (ISR) Capabilities at HQ USAF/A2. He oversighted ISR collection systems, including all manned ISR aircraft and many guick-reaction capabilities. As Air Force lead to the OSD ISR Task Force, he coordinated with the Joint Staff, Services, NSA, DIA, NGA, NRO and coalition partners on ISR weapon systems developments, allocations and operations. Prior to his current assignment, Colonel Krishna commanded the 55th Operations Group, Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska, executing worldwide reconnaissance, command and control, presidential support and treaty verification missions directed by the President, the Secretary of Defense, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, combatant commanders and national intelligence agencies. This largest operations group in the Air Force, flew six different aircraft models from twelve squadrons and two detachment operating from eleven locations.

Colonel Krishna is a master navigator with over 2,000 flying hours.
