Lou came into possession of a drawing /painting entitled "TELL TWO at 4" rendered by Maj Eugene "Gene" Djouswski an Aircraft Commander in the 343rd which Lou subsequently donated to the 55th now perhaps displayed in the new Headquarters Building.
