

## **Paulamarie C. Turner**

**March 29, 1948 - July 20, 2020**



Paula passed away on Monday, July 20, 2020 after a nearly three year battle with stage IV metastatic breast cancer. Paula was born in Boston, MA on March 29th, 1948 to Paul and Marie (nee Skerry) Moriarty and spent her early years growing up on the South Shore, primarily in Braintree and Squantum. She graduated from North Quincy High School in 1966 and almost immediately went to work in Boston's financial district for firms such as State Street Bank and Tucker, Anthony and R.L. Day. Paula also leaves one brother, Kevin Moriarty and his wife Linda living in Whitman, MA.
