Col Alan (Al) Feldkamp served as Commander of the 343rd Strategic Reconnaissance Squadron (SRS) with an RC-135 career encompassing COBRA BALL, COMBAT SENT AND RIVET JOINT operations; serving as an Electronic Warfare Office (EWO/Raven), instructor, evaluator, and Crew Commander. Prior to his RC-135 service, Col Feldkamp honed his ELINT expertise flying critical EB-66 Southeast Asia missions. As a COBRA BALL Tactical Coordinator, Feldkamp led Search and Rescue operations for a USN P-3C ditched off the Kamchatka Peninsula. In HQ SAC, Col Feldkamp advocated the RIVET JOINT Block 2 ELINT upgrade. At HQ USAF, Feldkamp served in Programs and Resources securing vital funding for BIG SAFARI's RC-135 fleet initiatives. Following his 343rd SRS and National War College assignments, Col Feldkamp became the Chief of the Joint Staff's Reconnaissance Operation Division/Joint Reconnaissance Center (JRC) overseeing DoD's worldwide Sensitive Reconnaissance Operations (SRO).
